The 12 Traditions of A.A.  
1. Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon A.A. unity.  
2. For our group purpose, there is but one authority, a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants; they do not govern.  
3. The only requirement for A.A. membership is a desire to stop drinking.  
4. Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups. Or A.A. as a whole.  
5. Each group has but one primary purpose—to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers.  
6. An A.A. group ought never endorse, finance, or lend the A.A. name to any related facility, or outside enterprise, lest problems of money, property and prestige divert us from our primary purpose.  
7. Every A.A. group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions.  
8. Alcoholics Anonymous should remain forever non-professional, but our service centers may employ special workers.  
9. A.A., as such, ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.  
10. Alcoholics Anonymous has no opinion on outside issues; hence the A.A. name ought never to be drawn into public controversy.  
11. Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films.  
12. Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities.

**12 Rewards of the 12 Step Program**

1. Hope instead of desperation.
2. Faith instead of despair.
3. Courage instead of fear.
4. Peace of mind instead of confusion.
5. Self-respect instead of self-contempt.
6. Self-confidence instead of helplessness.
7. The respect of others instead of their pity and contempt.
8. A clean conscience instead of a sense of guilt.
9. Real friendships instead of loneliness.
10. A clean pattern of life instead of a purposeless existence.
11. The love and understanding of our families instead of their doubts and fears.
12. The freedom of a happy life instead of the bondage of an Alcoholic obsession.
